



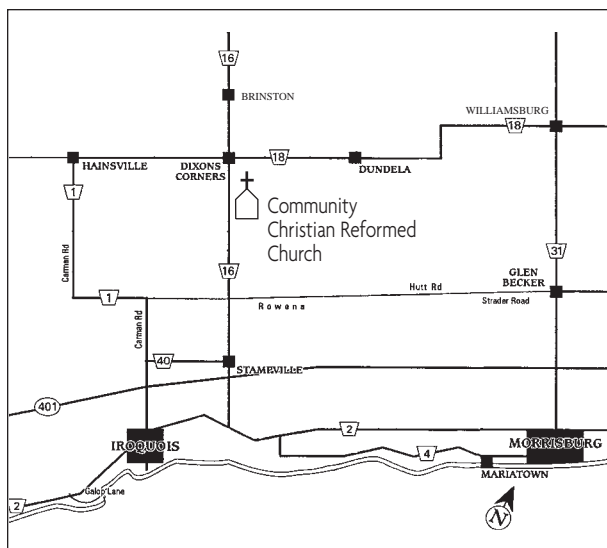
On behalf of Community Christian Reformed Church, I'd like to welcome you to our church.
